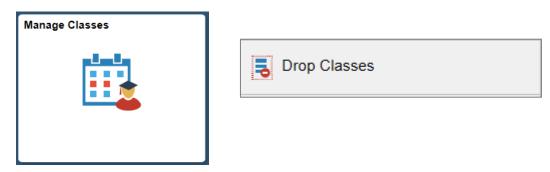
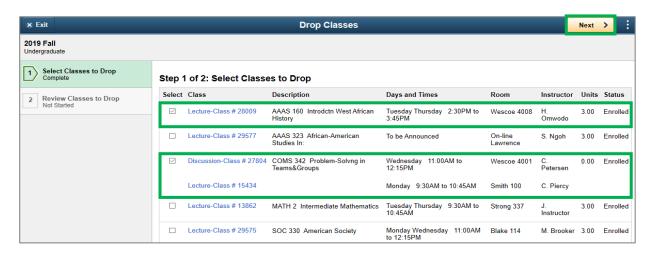

Dropping a Class

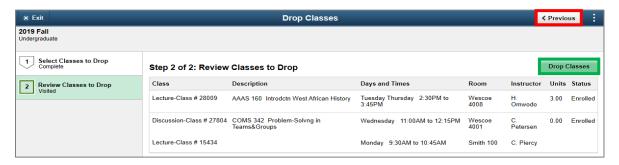
To drop a class, first start in the Manage Classes tile on the Student Homepage and click on the Drop Classes link:
